

Organizations or agencies considering completing an HSIP form for an Aging at Home initiative should consider the following questions:

- How will the initiative support seniors living independently and with dignity in their homes?
- How consistent is the initiative with the values, principles, directions and priorities in the Central West LHIN's Integrated Health Services Plan?
- How extensive has the consultation been and any partnership proposed with other service providers in the Central West LHIN?
- What seniors population (for example, seniors with complex needs, active seniors) does this initiative intend to support?
- To what extent is does the initiative result in the following?
 - *Improves access and reduces barriers to services for seniors*
 - *Addresses gaps in services to seniors that would support them in their homes*
 - *Better integrates services across the health system*
 - *Eases movement through the system*
 - *Achieves clinical and operational excellence through evidence-based practice*
 - *Improves the quality of services for seniors*
 - *Improves safety*
 - *Increases service efficiencies*
- How does the initiative demonstrate new, innovative approaches to providing services to seniors?
- What performance indicators have been developed by which the initiative can be monitored and evaluated?
- Has the initiative indicated how implementation challenges will be addressed?
