Shelburne Stats:

- Presence in Shelburne since 1985
- Satellite office (currently at the Mel Lloyd Centre) for over 15 years
- 1 counsellor available in Shelburne for 3.5 hours a week

Number of women served, April 2009 to present:

- 28 unique women at the Mel Lloyd location

Shelburne women who received service in Orangeville:

- 23 received sexual assault counselling
- 21 received abuse counselling
- 6 received crisis call support for sexual assault
- 27 received crisis call support for abuse
- 16 participated in various groups
- 13 received transitional/legal support

Vision for the Future

- Opportunity for Shared Group Room for Youth, Community and therapeutic counselling groups
- Additional Counselling hours
- Increased Capacity for one on one counselling
- Potential for increased outreach services in Shelburne (i.e. transitional support) to decrease the need for travel to Orangeville

- Partners with Headwaters Healthcare, Dufferin Child and Family Services to comprise the Sunrise Sexual Assault Program
- Good working relations with Shelburne Police and Dufferin OPP
