Volunteer Visiting Program

- Volunteers provide emotional, social, spiritual support to those who are living with a life-threatening illness
- Volunteers are assigned a client and follow the client/family throughout the continuum of care including home, hospital, long-term care facility

- In Shelburne

Total number of palliative clients from Dufferin
County 2008-9

- 34 from Shelburne
- 9 from North of Shelburne

Hospice Fundraised Programs

In Shelburne and Dufferin County

- Management of clients not receiving volunteer support
- Bereavement one-on-one support
- Bereavement groups

In Orangeville (exclusively)

- Circles ½ day program
- Lending Library (books, DVDs, etc)
- Wig and hats exchange
- Look Good Feel Better Program
- Breast Cancer support group

Hospice Funded Programs

- Total number of bereavement clients from Dufferin County 2008-9
 - 29 from Shelburne
 - 7 from North of Shelburne
- Total number of Circles ½ day program clients from Shelburne in 2008-9 = 3




Partnerships

Partnerships

- Shelburne Library provides space for one-on-one bereavement support and groups
- Shelburne Ministerial -referrals and we have done bereavement education sessions
- Mel Lloyd Family Health team – make referrals for bereavement and palliative services
