The successful candidate will be responsible for planning and integration initiatives, including conducting analysis of local health care services, identifying gaps in the local health care system, and working closely with diverse health service stakeholders. The Planning, Integration and Community Engagement Consultant will work independently on some planning projects and as part of a team on other planning projects with Central West LHIN staff.

This position will have a central role in developing improvements in chronic disease prevention and management strategies and linking the LHIN's work to primary care.

Qualifications - The successful candidate will have post-secondary education or training in health administration, health planning, business administration or relevant field and exhibit an understanding of the Ontario health care system. You will have experience and success in complex planning initiatives, project management, working effectively in a team environment, and connecting to diverse health service stakeholders.
